



Chaperone Agreement

Thank you for volunteering to chaperone for the _____(team name/age group) for its participation in _____(name of event). Without chaperone volunteers, the Eugene Metro Fútbol Club (EMFC) would not be able to offer this experience to our players. For some players, this may be their first experience away from their family. As a club, we want to make sure that our players have a safe and positive experience. To that end, we ask that you carefully review the EMFC Travel Policy well in advance of travel and that you agree to follow the rules set forth below throughout the entire time that you serve as a chaperone.

While serving in the role of team chaperone, I agree to the following:

- I will always act in the best interests of the players I am chaperoning, using good judgment and prioritizing their safety above all else.
- I will be available for players' needs at all times, including overnight. I will make sure that all players and the coach know how to contact me by telephone.
- I will not be alone with any player other than my child.
- I will keep track of the whereabouts of all players for whom I am responsible. This includes maintaining a current list of all player's cell phone numbers. If I cannot locate a player after reasonable effort, I will immediately contact the coach and/or player's parent or guardian.
- I will be on-time for all events, games, practices and meals where I am serving as a chaperone.
- I will make sure that all players are in their assigned rooms at curfew and I will not leave the lodging where I am assigned after curfew.
- I will maintain a positive attitude. I will never yell at a player, swear or speak disrespectfully in the presence of players, or engage in public arguments with the coach or other official of EMFC.
- When a vehicle is rented for the purpose of transporting players, I will be the primary driver of that vehicle. I will follow all driving laws while in that role, specifically including staying at or under the speed limit, not using any hand-held devices or having other distractions while driving, and ensuring that all players are using safety restraints. I will not let any person drive players in the team vehicle that has not been authorized to do so by an EMFC official.
- I will not consume or possess illegal substances or marijuana. I will not consume alcohol or be under the influence of alcohol or use tobacco while in the presence of players.
- If I observe or receive a report of inappropriate behavior or EMFC policy violation by or from a player, chaperone, coach, or EMFC official I will report that behavior immediately. For a player I will report the behavior to the coach and/or the Director of Coaching. For chaperone, coach, or EMFC official behavior I will report that behavior to the Director of Coaching or a Board Member.
- I will follow the EMFC Parent Code of Conduct.

If I violate any of the foregoing rules while acting as a chaperone, I agree to immediately correct the error if I am needed to continue as a chaperone for the remainder of the trip. If, instead, I am released from my responsibilities as a chaperone, I will bear the cost to return home.
